

SUBJECT: Rule Revisions to Chapter 3701-34 of the Ohio Administrative Code

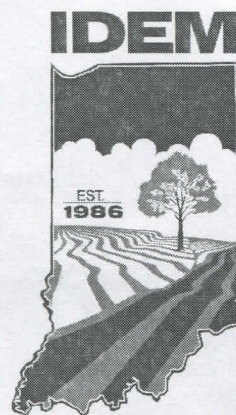

Recently, the Public Health Council adopted several revisions to Chapter 3701-34 of the Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.). The effective date of the rule revisions is **September 1, 2010**. Ohio Department of Health (ODH) strongly recommends that you review all the revised rules. The revised rules are available on the ODH website at www.odh.ohio.gov or by request. The key revisions include:

- Asbestos Hazard Evaluation Specialists shall collect all bulk samples for asbestos in accordance with the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) 40 CFR Part 763.86 [O.A.C. 3701-34-06(C)(9)] and prepare a detailed AHERA type report for each site where bulk samples are collected [O.A.C. 3701-34-06(C)(10)]. A transition period has been established to allow Asbestos Hazard Evaluation Specialists to develop procedures and reports that will comply with this new rule. This requirement which will become mandatory on January 1, 2011;
- The requirement for two (2) current, original, and clear, one inch by one inch, color photographs to accompany each ODH Application for Certification has been changed to only one (1) photograph and the size requirement has been eliminated [O.A.C. 3701-34-03(A)(2)]. The photograph size requirement has also been eliminated for the photograph on training certificates issued by ODH approved training providers. [O.A.C. 3701-34-07(B)(5)];

RE: Asbestos License Online Renewal

Effective September 1st, 2010, the Indiana Asbestos Licensing Program will begin accepting contractor and individual asbestos license renewals online. Online renewal is fast and convenient. If renewing online, an applicant is not required to submit training certificates and photographs. The renewal can be completed at <http://mylicense.in.gov>. A renewal notice containing a personal login ID and password will be mailed to each applicant sixty (60) days prior to their current license expiration date. The personal login ID and password will be required to renew a license online. The online renewed license is mailed within one business day. The applicant must use a credit card from Discover, MasterCard, Visa or a bank debit card to pay the license fee. Each online renewal will incur a processing fee in addition to the license fee. Please inform students of this new asbestos licensing service. Additionally, an online training video explaining the new asbestos license service is available for individuals and contractors. The asbestos online video tutorial is available at both of the following websites under the label "Asbestos License Renewal Web Tutorial" and sub-label "*A training video to guide users through the license renewal process for Individuals and Contractors*".
